Sauvignon Blanc

- 2017 Amadio, Black Label, Sauvignon Blanc, Adelaide Hills, SA 10/38**
This is a finely balanced blend of two great white varieties. Displaying aromas of fruit salad with hints of passion fruit and cut grass, with tropical fruit flavours finishing light and clean. A delightful wine with seafood.
- 2017 Catalina Sounds, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ 14/51**
Soft and approachable, with citrus and white stone fruit drive interwoven with tropical fruits and herbal notes.
- 2017 Te Mata “Cape Crest” Sauvignon Blanc, Hawkes Bay, NZ 47**
The palate is very long, dry, and concentrated, with great depth of lime, currant, pear flavour with sea salt and a fresh acid tension that lasts for minutes.
- 2017 Shaw & Smith Sauvignon Blanc Adelaide Hills, SA 58**
Lively and aromatic with notes of passionfruit, nashi pear, and nettles. On the palate there is intense flavor, with fresh, limey fruit, mouthwatering acidity, and remarkable purity. It is bone dry and unoaked to maintain freshness
- 2017 Dalrymple, Sauvignon Blanc, Coal River, TAS 52**
This Sauvignon Blanc was sourced from 3 sites, with the majority coming from the Tamar Valley and smaller amounts from the Coal Valley and Pipers River. This wine is a pale straw colour with aromas of passionfruit.
- 2016 Leeuwin Estate, ‘Silblings’ Sav/Semillon, Margaret River WA 46**
Savoury, fragrant and complex, a myriad of aromats and primary fruits. Leeuwin Estate is arguably one of the best Vineyards in Australia and the wine shows this.
- 2016 De Beurapaire “Billet Doux”, Sem/Sav Blanc Rhylstone, NSW 45**
Traditional crisp, dry Bordeaux-style (left bank) blend of 95% Semillon and 5% sauvignon blanc. Aromas of zesty lemon and lime with hints of tropical character

Chardonnay

- 2017 Amadio, White Label, Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, SA 10/40**
This is a finely balanced blend of two great white varieties. Displaying aromas of fruit salad with hints of passion fruit and cut grass, with tropical fruit flavours finishing light and clean. A delightful wine with seafood.
- 2017 Snake & Herring “Tough Love” Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA 12/45**
Tight palate structures complemented by subtle oak, long fruit profiles supported by natural acidity. Grapefruit, lime brulee and almond meal aromatics show through with a hint of spicy oak to add complexity.
- 2017 Pipers Brook, Estate, Chardonnay Tamar Valley, Tasmania 69**
Delicate and steely aroma’s, lush green fruits, apple, pear, citrus and limes, washed river bed quartz, vanilla bean spice from fermentation in fine French oak barriques. The palate is clean, fresh, vibrant and mineral tight.
- 2016 Scorpo Aubaine, Chardonnay, Mornington Peninsula, Vic 48**
All fruits from Paul Scorpo vineyard are grown organically. Chardonnay made with no new oak, it is his “Chablis” style, great minerality and expression of the fruits.
- 2016 Vasse Felix “Filius” Chardonnay, Margaret River, WA 53**
Lovely lemon biscuit, with light peach and pineapple notes. The palate lands soft and creamy with a rapid mouth-watering acidity.
- 2016 De Beaurepaire Reserve Jeanette, Chardonnay, Rhylstone, NSW 70**
Vibrant clear & golden, a full bodied, yet elegant modern French-style cool climate chardonnay with complex aromatics and taste of citrus and stone fruits.
- 2016 Shaw & Smith, M3 Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, SA 97**
M3 is at the forefront of the ongoing refinement and evolution of Australian Chardonnay.
- 2014 Domaine William Ferve, Chablis, Burgundy, France 80**
Combining fruitiness with an attractive freshness and characteristic minerality, Chablis is a wine region with global renown. Domaine William Fèvre’s vineyards sit on Kimmeridgian subsoil and enjoy ideal exposures for the fine wine.

Pinot Noir

- 2017 Nanny Goat Vineyard, Pinot Noir,** Central Otago, NZ **14/52**
The entry to the palate is rich, with sweet berry fruits nicely balanced by mouth-watering juicy acidity
- 2016 Pipers Brook, Estate Pinot Noir,** Tamar Valley, Tasmania **78**
A diverse range of concentrated berry flavours, It could only be Tasmanian, sweet vibrant berry fruits, floral and spice, the palate is finely stated, concentrated with depth and weight, dark fruit cake, sweet fleshy cranberries and cherries, the long delicate flavours explore your palate with excitement.
- 2016 Brockenchack “Hare Hunter” Pinot Noir,** Eden Valley, Barossa **57**
Unveiling colours of scarlet and crimson with bright pink hues, our inaugural release of Eden Valley Pinot Noir delicately reveals fresh aromas of cranberry, raspberry and cherry. Much sought after fruit ripeness has been retained, with red fruits underlined by bramble and clove notes, vanilla and soft white pepper.
- 2016 Nanny Goat Vineyards “Super Nanny” Pinot Noir** Central Otago, NZ **95**

This is a beautifully aromatic and textured Pinot Noir, with intensity, power, purity and complexity
- 2013 Two Paddocks, Pinot Noir,** Central Otago, NZ **160**
The Last Chance is a beautifully sited small terrace perched in bright clear air above the Earnsclough Valley, carefully planted with well-tended Burgundian clone pinot noir.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- 2015 Jim Barry “The Cover Drive” Cabernet Sauvignon,** Clare Valley/Coonawarra, SA **12/46**
The Cover Drive is a rich and vibrant Clare Valley Cabernet Sauvignon with all the mocha and chocolate characters you expect from the famed Shiraz region.
- 2015 Two Hands ‘Sexy Beast’ Cabernet Sauvignon** McLaren Vale, SA **59**
Lovely energy and density across the palate. Flavours mirror the aroma with everything in proportion with lovely balance. A premium Cabernet Sauvignon that deserves the finest of foods.
- 2015 Amadio, Cabernet Sauvignon, Single Vineyard,** Adelaide Hills, SA **65**
This full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon reflects classic Cabernet. This intense wine opens into ripe mulberry, hints of mint and tobacco leave with overtones of cedar and spice. A warm, mellow wine of very fine style that has been aged in French barriques, new and old, for 26 months.
- 2013 Bellwether Cabernet Sauvignon,** Coonawarra, SA **80**
Sue Bell is well known for picking her grapes earlier than most around Coonawarra. Her Cab sav is extremely elegant, cherry and cassis, palate is super succulent, very juicy with purity, perfume and finesse.
- 2007 De Beurepaire Reserve ‘Victor’ Cabernet Sauvignon** Rhyllstone, NSW **90**
A rare treat – 'Victor' 2007 is a 10-year-old, lovingly handcrafted wine from stellar vintage. Fermented traditionally in open vats, with final maturation for 15 months in a mixture of old and new French barriques. Cool mint and cassis characteristics, sustained flavour. Silky smooth.
- 2013 Yalumba “the Signature” Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz,** Barossa Valley, SA **134**
Almost blood red, this is a Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz in motion, changing and shifting from red scents of currants and cranberries to the black fruits of plum compote and black cherries, before a touch of cedar, leafy herbs and powdery black spices freshen the finish.

Shiraz

- 2017 Amadio, Black label, Shiraz,** Adelaide Hills, SA **10/42**
This is a powerful Aussie red with plenty of Shiraz fruit flavour and supportive oak tannins. Intense plum and raspberry fruit aromas with subtle hints of liquorice, cedar and spice. Spicy tannins on the finish.
- 2017 Brockenchack “Zip Line” Shiraz,** Eden Valley, Barossa **14/50**
This Shiraz is traditionally made by partially crushing the grapes into open top fermenters, then basket pressed and left to mature in seasoned French oak hogsheads for 18 months. To be enjoyed now and for years to come.
- 2016 Wirra Wirra “Woodhenge” Shiraz,** McLaren Vale, SA **60**
Darkly coloured and jam-packed with blackberry, tar, anise and a lick of dried herbs. Plush and expansive, finely grained tannins hold everything in check.
- 2013 Brockenchack “Jack Harrison” Shiraz,** Eden Valley, Barossa **97**
The Shiraz is handpicked from 90 year old vines, aged for 24 months in new French oak. Being only a stone's throw from the Hill of Grace patch you can expect a cracking drop.

Vintage and Cellar collection

- 2012 Rusden “Black Guts” Shiraz,** Barossa Valley, SA **150**
Rusden was founded in 1979 by Christine and Dennis Canute who bought 40 acres in the Barossa Valley This Shiraz is complex, ripe, but not jammy, very good structure to the medium-bodied, multi-fruit and spice flavours, good extract and oak.
- 2014 Yalumba “The Octavius” Shiraz,** Barossa Valley, SA **170**
Almost blood red, this is a Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz in motion, changing and shifting from red scents of currants and cranberries to the black fruits of plum compote and black cherries, before a touch of cedar, leafy herbs and powdery black spices freshen the finish.
- 2013 Brockenchack “William Fredericks” Shiraz,** Eden Valley, SA **220**
Very small batch of the most premium fruit handpicked With 30 months on new French oak, one of the most well rounded and balanced Shiraz on the market.
- 2014 Brockenwood Graveyard Shiraz,** Hunter Valley, NSW **280**
A wonderfully complex, yet medium-bodied wine that melds savoury notes with dark fruit and gentle tannins. A delectable hero of the Hunter Valley.'
